











Colour Examples Where To Use

	Aisleways & Traffic Lanes; Paths of Egress; Work Cells.
	Production; Racks, Machines, Carts, Benches and other Equipment not under any colour guidelines.
	Defect/Scrap Area; Red Tag Area.
	Material or Product Inspection or energized Equipment.
	Materials & Manufacturing: Finished Goods.
	Materials & Manufacturing: Raw Materials.
	Materials & Manufacturing: Works in Progress.
	Areas which present physical or health risks to employees indicates that extra caution is to be exercised.
	Areas to be kept clear for safety reasons.
	Areas to be kept clear for operational purposes, non-safety related.

These Guidelines are based on visual management best practices and not necessarily tied to any particular regulation or industry standard. It is essential to post a colour guide in locations where everyone will notice them.

4 Key Steps To Floor Tape Installation



SWEEP & CLEAN

Ensure the area gets a good Sweep, clean and degrease.



DRY SURFACE

Allow floor surfaces to dry 100% before applying Tape.



APPLY

Apply tape to floor area slowly using a small roller.



TAMP

To increase Tape bond to the floor, you may drive something heavy or use a heavy tamp along the entire line.
